

Previously, Dr. DeCherney was the John Slate Ely Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Yale and the Division Director of Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility and Women's Health Services; and the Phaneuf Professor and Chair of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Tufts University School of Medicine; where he received the Outstanding Faculty Teaching Award.

He was the Director of the Division of Reproductive Endocrinology at the David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA from 1996 to 2006

and was Chair of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology from 1996 to 2002.

He is a Fellow of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists; Past President of the American Society for Reproductive Medicine (formerly the American Fertility Society); a Past President of the Society for Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility, the Society of Reproductive Surgeons, and the Society of Assisted Reproductive Technology. He is a Member of the American Gynecological and Obstetrical Society and a Past President of the Society for Gynecologic Investigation. He is the recipient of the President's Achievement Award of the Society of Gynecologic Investigation

He is the Editor-in-Chief of the journal, **Fertility and Sterility**, and was an Associate Editor and Editorial Board Member of the **New England Journal of Medicine** and Member of the Editorial Board of **Obstetrics and Gynecology**.


